

Frequently asked Questions

Q1: When does KNLL Softball/Baseball season begin and end:

A1: Practices begin the first week in March and Games usually start the end of April and run through mid-June. Post season play (All-Stars) can run into August.

Q2: When will I be notified concerning what team I am on?

A2: For Majors and AAA Baseball you should receive a call by early-mid-February (after evaluations). For younger divisions players should be notified by mid-February.

Q3: Can I request my son/daughter to be with a coach or player?

A3: Players in T-ball, A-ball, and AA-ball baseball can have one request to be placed on a team for either a specific coach or player. Depending on the Team, this may not apply to Late Registered applicants.

Player request are not allowed for AAA and Majors Baseball where a draft is in place.

Q4: What are the divisions by grade school?

A4:

T-ball is generally for kindergarten with some first grade players that need more time learning

A-ball is generally for 1st and 2nd grade school kids (league age 7-8 or 6 with one yr of T-ball)

AA-ball is generally for 3rd grade school kids (league age 9 or those with 2 years of A-ball)

AAA-ball is generally for 4th and 5th grade school kids (league age 10-11, or having played AA-ball)

Majors BB is generally for 4th, 5th and 6th grade school kids (league age 10-12)
